HONORS DISCIPLINE GRADUATE

A bachelor's degree student who completes 4 Honors designation projects in 4 upper-level courses in their major with a grade of B or better and has an overall GPA of at least 3.5 is designated an Honors Discipline Graduate.

The Honors Program at Middle Georgia State University is designed to help academically advanced students develop their intellectual potential through even more challenging educational activities. Honors classes at MGA provide an opportunity for high-achieving MGA students to pursue their academic greatness.

Students may earn Honors credit by completing special projects of sufficient creativity, depth, or scope to warrant an Honors designation. Courses for which these projects are satisfactorily completed are designated as Honors classes on the student's transcript. All Honors course designation projects must be approved in advance by the Honors Program Director.

Program Requirements

- Take 4 Honors course designations in upper-level major courses
- Complete each course with a grade of A or B
- Maintain an overall GPA of 3.5
