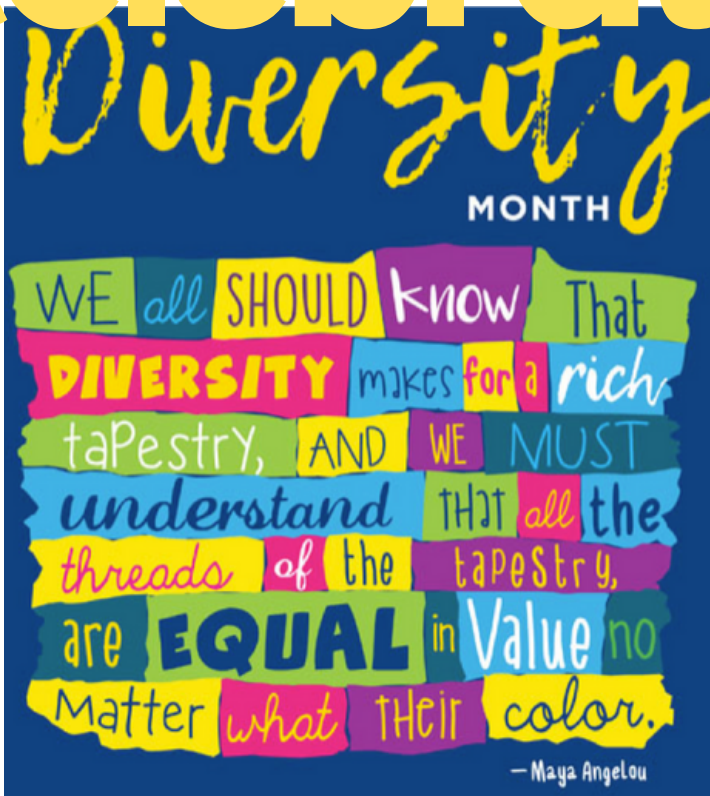
THE OFFICE RECAP | REWIND
