Criteria for Faculty Fellows

- Terminal degree (PhD, EdD, etc.) in a relevant discipline such as sociology, public policy, nursing, health, natural sciences, history, business, urban planning, public health, education, etc.
- Demonstrated record of research/scholarship related to community issues
- Experience teaching courses or leading programs focused on civic/community engagement
- Proven track record of successful community-based research projects
- Established relationships and experience working with community organizations
- Skills in facilitating community meetings, focus groups, charrettes, etc.
- Commitment to principles of community-engaged scholarship
- Openness to working across disciplines on complex community issues
- Ability to connect siloed perspectives into holistic solutions
- Experience leading or participating in interdisciplinary teams
- Strong collaboration and communication skills
- Cultural competence working with underserved/marginalized groups
- Ability to engage diverse community stakeholders authentically
