

Casio Cassiopeia A-10

The Casio Cassiopeia A-10 palmtop computer was the first model of the Cassiopeia series of Personal Digital Assistants (PDAs) manufactured by Casio. It used Windows CE 1.0 as the operating system and had a Hitachi SH-3 CPU at 44 MHz. It had 2 MB of RAM and 4 MB of ROM, and a LCD display with 480 x 240 pixels and 4 shades of gray. It also had a serial port, an IrDA port, a PC card slot, a keyboard and a touch screen. It was released in November 1996 in the US for under \$500.
