**D. Douglas Miller, MD CM, MBA, FACPC, FACC, FAHA**

Dr. Miller has uniquely served as the Dean and Chief Academic Officer of three research-intensive medical schools, and as a member of the Liaison Committee for Medical Education (LCME) while chairing its Canadian MD program national accrediting body (CACMS).

Dr. Miller has led teams across complex public & private university landscapes to innovate in medicine & science, and to grow the health professions workforce to meet the needs of underserved communities. Dr. Miller has advised global health policy organizations (i.e., University of California Berkeley, The NHS King's Fund) and technology companies (i.e., IBM Watson Health, Philips Healthcare).

He holds U.S. patents in new drug development, advanced medical imaging, and artificial intelligence (AI). His biotech incubator directorships and invited lectures reflect his leading authority status on emerging technology applications (such as AI) in translational research, healthcare, and health professions education.
