



Psi Rho Chapter

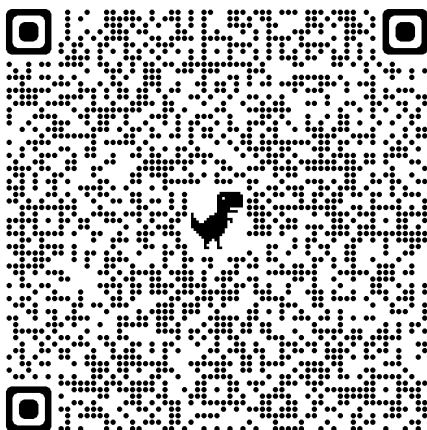
