

Faculty Certification of Credentials

For each of its educational programs, the institution justifies and documents the qualifications of its faculty members (SACSCOC 6.2.a, effective January 2018). MGA employs competent faculty members qualified to accomplish the mission and goals of the institution. When determining acceptable qualifications primary consideration is given to highest degree earned in the discipline. Consideration is also given to the individual's competence, effectiveness, and capacity, including as appropriate, undergraduate and graduate degrees, related work experiences in the field, professional licensure and certifications, honors and awards, continuous documented excellence in teaching, or other demonstrated competencies and achievements that contribute to effective teaching and student learning outcomes. Beginning AY 2018-2019, all graduate faculty must have on file a memo assigning them to Graduate Faculty Status or, if they do not hold a terminal degree in area, a memo assigning them to Provisional Graduate Faculty Status (see MGA Graduate Credentialing Guidelines 2019-2020).
