### Evidence of changes based on an analysis of results

What changes were implemented based on an analysis of the students' performance on these Student Learning Outcomes? In AY 2018-2019, IDS continued to implement our SLO 2 learning initiative from AY 2017-2018. Students in the IDS cultural studies elective courses submitted outlines and bibliographies of their research papers to the instructor before the IDS cultural studies elective course research paper came due. They received instructor comments on these submissions to help them prepare and write more successful cultural studies research papers (SLO 2). This extra feedback aimed to help the students excel in their IDS cultural studies research papers, which is the measurement for SLO 2. The rate of success improved in AY 2018-2019; it went from from 50% in AY 2017-2018 to 74% in AY 2018-2019. This is a marked improvement. Still, it is below the goal of 80%. Because SLO 2 is the only SLO not to meet the student success rate of 80% in AY 2018-2019, the AY 2019-2020 learning initiative will address this goal. SLO 2 measures student success on the research essay in the cultural studies elective courses. For AY 2019-2020, students in the IDS cultural studies elective courses will submit outlines and bibliographies for their research essays (SLO 2) before they come due. Instructors will not only provide comments on these outlines and bibliographies, but also will assign a grade. Putting the weight of a grade on this assignment, should encourage students to address it more rigorously and thus benefit more fully from the instructor feedback.
