The average score came up 6 points from the previous cohort. The mechanics and APA are the two leading issues with student papers with this being their 4th semester in the program. This cohort has had several APA workshops. We will incorporate an APA entry quiz with the biggest problems that students make. We are also going to let the students provide feedback each other's work prior to submission.
