However, the goal for SLO 2 in 2020-2021 was not met (see data above in SLO 2). Assessment Initiative/Plan for Upcoming Year: The IDS curriculum committee met regarding SLO 2, and the following learning initiative will be implemented for 2021-22 in IDS 3800: students will hand in a draft of the paper prior to the final paper submission. To ensure continuous improvement, additional plans have been developed to assess curricular changes: The IDS curriculum committee passed several curricular changes this year that will be implemented in AY21-22 and that will impact in which classes and how SLO1 and SLO3 will be assessed. A summary of these changes is provided below: SLO 1 will now be assessed in HUMN 2151, 2155, or 2156. No changes made to the rubric. SLO 2 will now be assessed in HUMN 3800. No changes made to the rubric. SLO 3 continues to be assessed in the same classes but the instrument has been changed to allow either a paper or a project and the rubric has been updated to reflect this change.
