BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN BIOLOGY

The B.S. in Biology is appropriate for students who:

- Want to enter professional programs in health sciences, such as medicine, dentist physician's assistant, physical therapy, veterinary and pharmacology
- Want to enter graduate programs in biological sciences or related fields
- Want to complete a bachelor's degree and pursue employment in biological sciences, such as botany, natural resource management, microbiology, toxicology and entomology
- Want to teach high school biology



What can you do with a Biology Degree?

Research – research technician, research associates, professional programs that offer degrees in a research specialty

Healthcare – professional programs that offer training in medicine, pharmacy, veterinary medicine, physician assistants, optometry, dentistry, medical technology clinical laboratories

Education – teaching in elementary, middle or high school

Journalism - journalist, technical manuscript writing

Administration and management – grants administration, biotechnology and pharmaceutical firms, biological sales representative

Government – natural resource management, environmental regulation and management, forest management, water quality and control, government inspection agencies, health organizations, science policy analysts

Industry - pharmaceuticals, biotechnology, food, agriculture
