Thank you for your letter of August 11, 2016, providing notification that the University will offer the Bachelor of Science degree in Interdisciplinary Studies, effective August 2016.

The program will be offered on the main campus and online. The University offers the approved Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies and the new program builds on existing curriculum. Thus the B.S. in Interdisciplinary Studies is not significantly different from approved programs currently offered.

Because the program is similar to approved programs offered by the University and will not require significant additional resources, it is not considered to be a substantive change requiring approval.
